The Harrison Township Board of Trustees met in regular session with President, Thomas C. Losekamp, calling the meeting to order. Answering the roll call were: Frederick A. Dole, William R. Noes and Thomas C. Losekamp.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Dole made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 15, 2019 regular meeting. Mr. Losekamp seconded the motion, roll call - all yea.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT

Mr. Losekamp made a motion to approve the Fiscal Officer's Financial Report, which includes the payment of the bills. Mr. Dole seconded the motion, roll call - all yea.

VISITORS

Ms. Michelle Elliott, Branch Manager of the Harrison Branch of the Hamilton County Public Library System, was present and provided an update on all the programs that will be offered this summer at the library.

POLICE REPORT

Sergeant Jeremy DePaoli, was present and distributed the following monthly reports: Criminal Investigation Section; Hamilton County Communications Summary; Uniform Incident and Traffic Crash.

Mr. Dole reported that a black Camaro has been observed speeding in the early evening hours along with two other cars on Lees Creek and New Biddinger Roads. Sgt. DePaoli will notify his officers to be aware of this situation.

Mr. Losekamp reported that he received a complaint from a resident on Marvin Road regarding a neighbor parking their truck at the end of their driveway. This situation blocks the vision for other neighbors to pull out of their own driveways. Sgt. DePaoli stated there is nothing that can be done as long as the truck is not in the right-of-way.

FIRE REPORT

Mr. Noes reported that the City of Harrison has received their new fire truck and has been testing it before putting it into service.

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ZONING REPORT

There was no report.

NUISANCE ABATEMENT REPORT

Mr. Dole reported that an emergency nuisance letter was sent to the property owner at 11113 Flora Road on May 29, 2019 because of the grass and weeds that were growing to nearly four feet tall. Since the letter was sent, the property owner has taken care of the problem.

A nuisance letter was sent to the property owner at 8971 Flintwood Drive. This property has also been cleaned up.

A nuisance letter was sent to the property owners at 1110 New Biddinger Road regarding various violations. Not all of the violations have been remedied, therefore Mr. Dole requested that our legal counsel send another nuisance letter regarding the items still in violation.

Mr. Dole is also going to ask legal counsel to send a nuisance letter to the property owner of the Produce Stand on Harrison Avenue regarding the truck, two trailers and refrigerator trailer parked on the grass.
