MINUTES OF HARRISON TOWNSHIP BOARD TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING

OPENING

The Harrison Township Board of Trustees met in regular session with Chairman, Thomas C. Losekamp, calling the meeting to order. Answering the roll call were: Frederick A. Dole and Thomas C. Losekamp. Mark A. Louis was absent with notice.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Losekamp made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 18, 2021 regular meeting. Mr. Dole seconded the motion, roll call – all ye.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT

Mr. Dole made a motion to approve the Fiscal Officer's Financial Report, which includes the payment of the bills. Mr. Losekamp seconded the motion, roll call – all ye.

VISITORS

Debbie Eldridge spoke and inquired about the status of the Love's Truck Stop development. Mr. Losekamp explained Love's representative withdrew the application with the County and there's no further issues with the property.

Debbie Eldridge also inquired about the scheduling of the pickle ball courts at the Community Center. It was understood that the use of the courts was first come first served. Some groups are not adhering to this understanding so Ms. Eldridge requested that some signage be installed to help regulate the usage. The board will look into having signs installed.

POLICE REPORT

Sgt. Oliver Albert of the Hamilton County Sheriff's office reported that the month of July had some noteworthy incidents. There were two theft reports. Criminal damaging, resisting arrest, criminal trespassing and child endangering. There were 8 total auto crashes and 4 OVI arrests. There were 161 calls for service in Harrison Township. Deputies responded to 79 calls for service and logged out 82 calls for service due to be on the look of, public services, EMS runs etc. The average response time for service was 12 minutes which is down 2 minutes from last month.

CORRESPONDENCE


Mr. Losekamp reminded everyone about the Township Clean-up day on Saturday September 25, 2021.
