OPENING

The Harrison Township Board of Trustees met in regular session with Chairman, Thomas C. Losekamp, calling the meeting to order. Answering the roll call were: Frederick A. Dole, Thomas C. Losekamp and Mark A. Louis.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Dole made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2022 regular meeting. Mr. Louis seconded the motion, roll call – all yea.

FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT

Mr. Louis made a motion to approve the Fiscal Officer's Financial Report, which includes the payment of the bills. Mr. Dole seconded the motion, roll call – all yea.

POLICE REPORT

Sgt. Oliver Albert of the Hamilton County Sheriff's office reported that there were a few noteworthy incidents in Harrison Township. There were 4 theft reports, 2 criminal damaging reports and an Identity fraud for the month of July. There was a total of 5 auto crashes. There were 159 calls for service in Harrison Township during this period. Deputies responded to 85 of those calls for service and logged out 74 calls for service due to Be On the Look Of, public services, EMS etc. The average response time to responded calls for service was 13 minutes, which is down 1 minute from last month.

Mr. Louis stated that he is meeting with the Fire Chief and other fire personnel tomorrow.

NUISANCE REPORT

Mr. Losekamp receive a formal complaint on two properties 11440 and 11542 Carolina Trace Road. Both properties are being addressed by the Hamilton County zoning and health departments. Further action will be determined after the inspection and assessment by the County.

BUSINESS REPORT

Mr. Losekamp informed that All Traffic Solutions invoice is due for renewal and wanted to inform the board and receive feedback. After some discussion it was determined that the Township should renew the contract and then when the new contract expires assess the need for future usage.

Mr. Losekamp gave an overview on the engineering design for the Dry Fork Road overpass and the financial commitment to the Township. After discussion Mr. Losekamp will contact the engineering firm to find out the status of the project.

A resolution prohibiting excessive noise was discussed at length and the board determined that a number of areas were vague and not specific enough. The Township legal firm will be contacted to assists in rewriting the resolution and then reviewed at a later date.

Mr. Dole announced that the Township fall clean-up is cancelled, but paper shredding is still schedule for Saturday September 24, 2002 at the Township Civic Center from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM.


ADJOURNMENT


