Mr. Losekamp made a motion to approve the depository agreement with KeyBank expiring on December 31, 2026. Mr. Dole seconded the motion, roll call- all yea.

Mr. Losekamp made a motion to approve the attendance and reimbursement of expenses for Township Employees and representatives at all state and national conferences, professional development conferences and meetings regarding township business during 2022. Mr. Louis seconded the motion, roll call – all yea.
