## **MINUTES OF HARRISON TOWNSHIP BOARD TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING**

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### **OPENING**

The Harrison Township Board of Trustees met in regular session with Chairman, Thomas C. Losekamp, calling the meeting to order. Answering the roll call were: Frederick A. Dole, Thomas C. Losekamp and Mark A. Louis

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Losekamp made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 15, 2021 regular meeting. Mr. Dole seconded the motion, roll call Mr. Dole – yea, Mr. Losekamp – yea, Mr. Louis abstain – motion passed.

### **FISCAL OFFICER'S REPORT**

Mr. Louis made a motion to approve the Fiscal Officer's Financial Report, which includes the payment of the bills. Mr. Losekamp seconded the motion, roll call – all yea.

### **VISITORS**

Laura Hobson introduced herself as the new reporter for the Harrison Press.

### **POLICE REPORT**

Sgt. Oliver Albert of the Hamilton County Sheriff's office reported that there were a few noteworthy incidents in Harrison Township, there were several theft reports in different areas of the township, sexual imposition, domestic violence, threats and misuse of a credit card. There were 5 auto crashes 2 with injury 3 with property damage. There were 175 calls for service in Harrison Township during this period. Deputies responded to 98 of those calls for service and logged out 77 calls for service due to Be on the Look Of, public services, EMS runs, etc. The average response time to responded calls for service was 12 minutes, which is down one minute from last month.

Mr. Dole made a motion to approve Colerain Township Trustee Matt Wahlert to represent the Hamilton County Township Association as representative to the Hamilton County Solid Waste Committee Board. Mr. Louis seconded the motion, roll call – all yea.

Mr. Losekamp informed everyone that Unilock Corp. is seeking certain abatements for a 50-million-dollar improvement at 8600 Southwest parkway. Discussion are being planned with our bond counsel and Hamilton County on the feasibility of the request and how it will affect the JEDD area and other issues. Brenda Wehmer from Dinsmore will attend the next township meeting to explain the procedures to pay off the remaining bonds in the JEDD and the plan for other improvements.

Mr. Losekamp announced that the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will conduct a meeting on February 2, 2022 with township representatives to discuss police services.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

Mr. Losekamp announced that The Hillwood Group is requesting a tax abatement on certain property located with the JEDD.


Mr. Dole informed the board that there may be another indigent burial in the Township

**ADJOURNMENT**


